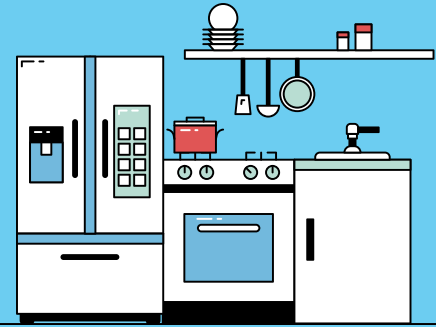


Open Showers

Clean Home:

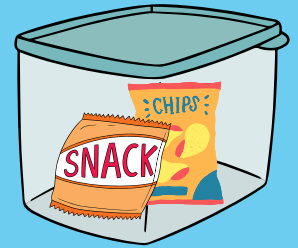
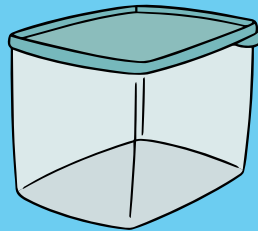
- Wipe living room stands

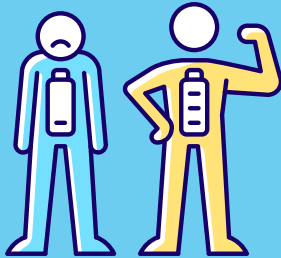

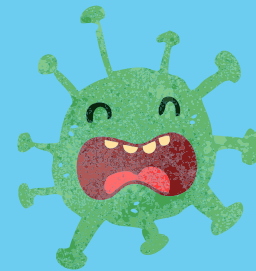
